The Inland Northwest campaign area covers the twelve northeastern Washington counties and ten northern Idaho counties. **WHAT IS THE COMBINED FEDERAL CAMPAIGN?**

CFC is the only authorized solicitation of employees in the Federal, Military and United States Postal Service workplace on behalf of charitable organizations. It continues to be the largest and most successful workplace fundraising model in the world. With a tradition of

commitment to the community through the selfless efforts of Federal employees, the CFC has its roots in the many charitable campaigns since the early 1960's. Seeing a need to bring the diversity of fundraising efforts under one umbrella, the CFC was created – one

campaign, once a year. In 2007, Federal employees around the world raised more than \$275 million for charitable causes around the world.





## What are the costs of the campaign?

### 2006 Charity Breakdown




